Remembering Pastor Tim Hoins



It is with the heaviest of hearts that we must announce that Pastor Tim Hoins was killed in an auto accident the afternoon of Friday, February 19, 2021. Please continue to pray for Tim's wife Kristy and their three sons, Nick, Connor and Josh.

For those of us associated with First Presbyterian Church, Hanford (CA), the news of the past couple of days regarding the tragic, unexpected passing of Tim Hoins, the newly installed and highly gifted pastor, is beyond comprehension and understanding. I'm sure that it felt like a gut punch for all of us upon first hearing the news. Of course, our first response is to ask, "Why?" How could something like this occur in light of Tim recently accomplishing so much toward his goal of becoming a pastor and his arrival in Hanford (with his bride, Kristy) only a few short months ago? It makes absolutely no sense!

So, how do we wrap our minds around this? We have to realize that there will be no answer forthcoming to the question "Why?" This is a tension that we all will have to wrestle with on this side of eternity. When Job asked God the "Why" question, God did not answer. He simply told Job, "Do not question my ways. I'm God. You are not." Job then realized God's presence was enough for him (Job 41:1-6). It is enough for us as well...his grace, mercy, forgiveness and love.

In processing all of this, we can be consoled with the knowledge that God is sovereign. He is in control of all things through his infinite knowledge, presence and power. Nothing takes him by surprise. Absolutely nothing! We can be consoled with the assurance of the end game...God defeats evil (in all of its forms) and will put all things to right (as NT Wright puts it).

One final thought: God can handle our honest questions and deep emotions (even anger...though we can't ultimately stay in a place of anger). Let us pour out our hearts to him in prayer, even as we ask him to sustain and protect the Hoins family through this deep, deep valley.

Let us also be buoyed by Romans 8:28, "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose." God can and will bring redemption out of this as we trust and obey him.
