Summary of May 19, 2020 Session Meeting

Deacons:

• Deacons reported their decision to support Kings Gospel Mission with the donations received.

Interim Search Committee:

- The Covenant agreement for Pastor Mark Nazarian was reviewed and approved.
- Mark Nazarian briefly joined the meeting and was introduced to session members. He shared his testimony of faith and answered a few questions.

Buildings & Grounds:

Repairs were made by an electrician to lighting fixtures in the sanctuary

Finance:

- Giving continues to be down. April ran a deficit of -\$714.16. Waiting on May figures.
- Projecting "Online Giving" option available in June with ability to designate funds.

Missions:

• Approved participation in the Crossroads Pregnancy Virtual Fundraiser.

Worship:

- Approved special gifts in honor of Father's Day.
- Approved allowing no more than 4 people at a time to practice and record music in sanctuary with special COVID restrictions.

Pastoral Search Committee:

• Motion to amend the number of members on committee to 5 with no alternates to comply with EPC Guidelines. <u>Other Session Business</u>:

- Approved allotment of \$500 to purchase hand sanitizing stations and product.
- Approved elimination of \$360 stipend previously allotted to Jaime Christoph, effective June 1st, 2020
- Approved reduction in pay by half salary beginning June 1, 2020, until church reopens, for Davena Clemente, Joe Dykes and Margie Fritz, with oversight by Personnel Committee.

Imagine a country with (officially) zero churches and zero Christian citizens. The Country's laws permit the employment of foreign Christians, but don't allow those foreign Christians to practice their faith openly. Citizens of the country can hear the gospel via satellite TV and the Internet but have no access to what is absolutely essential in most people's conversion – the opportunity to talk over questions with another person. The only way that can happen is if a non-citizen comes, overcomes the obstacles, and starts talking about peace with God through Jesus.


Several years ago, Jim and Shannon (not their real names for safety) were appointed by EPC World Outreach to go and make disciples of Jesus in such a country. As Jim completed his professional credentials in order to qualify for job openings, he and Shannon began World Outreach's TAG internship in Detroit. There they met people who were immigrants from their target country and they soon became close friends. When Jim accepted a job offer in their country, those neighbors made sure their relatives back home gave them the warmest of welcomes on arrival. Over the next several years, Shannon developed deep friendships with the women of this extended family and she talked with them about Jesus, and shared Bible stories with them. Last Christmas, Shannon gave each woman of the family a Bible so that they could read the stories themselves. Soon two sisters sensed God speaking to them and put their faith in Christ. They were captured by His love for them!

World Outreach (WO) is the mission sending agency of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church with the principal calling to glorify God by starting church-planting movements among least-reached people groups. Please pray for our missionaries through the EPC World Outreach that God will work through them to open doors bringing the Gospel to those who do not yet know HIM! Also, please pray for their safety while they serve the Lord living in sensitive areas or the world.

When logged into their Give+ account, donors can review giving history, manage recurring donations or edit stored payment methods.


