Do you ever count your blessings? Have you heard of The Heavenly Shower ministry?

The Pentecostal Church of God here in Hanford offers this important ministry to our community. The showers are located in a building separate from the church sanctuary. They are open weekly on Tuesday and Thursday from 6:15 am to 11am. The sign on the building says "All Welcome". FPC Deacons collect toiletries that benefit those who use the Heavenly Shower ministry. The travel sized bottles of shampoo, conditioner, lotion and soap that are offered at hotels are ideal, because each person who comes for a shower gets items just for their own use. However, any size toiletries you want to donate will be put to good use. There is a basket in the church hallway marked "Shower Ministry" where you can donate any items to aid in this helpful work. Please consider giving to 'the least of these' by giving some shampoo or other items that can bless this meaningful ministry, which is back in action after a hiatus last year during COVID-19 guarantine.

First Presbyterian Church partners with The Timothy Initiative through our church Missions Program and The Timothy Initiative disciples are making disciples that in turn make even more disciples! Villages with little to no access are hearing the name of Jesus for the first time! Some of The Timothy Initiative goals set for 2020 -2025 include seeing:

- 200,000 churches planted
- 5 million new disciples
- 150,000 vulnerable people cared for by the local church

In just 2021 alone thus far, The Timothy Initiative is celebrating over 60,000 new believers being reached with the Gospel. The quarterly update:

- 9,483 churches planted
- 64,253 new believers from the churches planted
- 14,059 baptisms
- 6,137 widows and orphans impacted by these local churches

The Timothy Initiative is committed to seeing a church in every village, among every people in every place. With the support of partners, field leaders, and team members, they prayerfully move forward in faith working to train disciple makers, reproduce leaders, and plant multiplying churches.

All around the world, church planters and new believers are expanding their ministries and going deeper in their relationship with the Lord but prayers are needed!!!

- Pray for their team members, field leaders, and partners around the globe to have a united vision and to be of one mind.
- Pray for hearts that are not shaken or discouraged by uncertainty or persecution.
- Pray for a renewed sense of urgency to reach those who are perishing without hearing the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Please keep all these leaders in prayer that the Lord will give them protection and guidance as they spread and share the gospel to the unreached! The Lord is doing GREAT things!!!





Jolly 1's &2's will be starting up again in September. The first activity will be to attend the Temple




Other outings will be planned. I was unable to find any dates for Kings Symphony. Second Space Theatre is now open. Other suggestions would be appreciated.







