May and September, now, in conclusion, remember my thesis – In **Preparation** for worship we wake to the Son on Sonday (Sunday) and prepare ourselves as we are Called by God opening our week with hymns of praise, prayers, litanies of invocation or confession to be set right before God. In the **Proclamation** time we hear what the Word of God means for our lives – seek the meaning. Our focus is on God's intent for us as delineated by Christ our Lord in word and deed.



The **final phase of our worship journey – Responding**. Some Sundays we respond with one of the mandated commandments of Christ. Either we respond with Baptism (...go and make disciples ... baptizing them...) or with Communion (...do this in remembrance of me.). Many Sundays we respond with prayers and petitions or other acts of thanks and dedication. In the sacraments (Baptism and Communion) we yield ourselves not to the direction and filling of the pastor, but to the very presence of the Body of Christ and the outpouring of God's Holy Spirit as our host for these events. On Sundays when the sacraments are not celebrated, the same reality exists.

As we **respond to the meaning of God's word in our life**, God's Holy Spirit pours out upon our lives sending us to a needy world. That world needs to hear and see the loving Christ. Since Christ's Spirit is invested in us as we respond to the Living Word, we are the Body of Christ given to the world. You are the living Word of God because you came and yielded yourself in worship. Think of the enormity of this statement. God has purified you and cleansed you in worship and now you are the best vessel possible to deliver the Good News.

Responding in worship is really the pinnacle event. Not the praise songs or the sermon. Not the confession or the hearing of the Word. Rather, a people now ready to go out to the world and be the Body of Christ, the Family of God. The final blessing and calling down of God's Great Spirit to fill you and send you to the world is the high point. God smiles and blesses the children and they go out to play and be happy and bring God's love to all – Worship completed.

This month begins with the celebration of World Communion Sunday. So, prepare yourself. Get ready to worship. Find the meaning of God's Word in your life, but watch out, because God is ready to respond, sending you into the world, not alone, but with God's Holy Spirit blessing your every step.

Cameroon, Africa FPC Mission Opportunity!

Are you ready to step "out of your box" and go on a Mission trip to Cameroon, Africa? What a wonderful opportunity to build relationships with the Efulan Presbyterian Church congregation in Cameroon, Africa, along with four other churches, sharing cultures, faith, experiences, gifts, and being a missionary from Hanford spreading the Gospel across the World!

WOW! When opportunity knocks – this is the time to step up and spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ to others!

The First Presbyterian Church Mission Ministry Team along with Paul Elansa has created a 14-day mission trip to Cameroon, Africa for members of our congregation in December 2023. Paul, a Cameroon native and member of our First Presbyterian Church and an Elder in the Efulan Presbyterian Church in Cameroon will be the guide every step of the way.

The proposed dates for the trip (although flexible) are December 1, 2023 – December 10, 2023 plus four days travel (2 days going – 2 days returning) to and from Cameroon. The itinerary includes five destinations, all food arrangements provided by a private chef, accommodations at (Hotels, B&B's and the Village Guest House in Efulan) and ground transportation.

Cost estimated at \$4,000 covers flight, food, housing, ground transportation and Visa fees. Immunizations needed for travel & Covid restrictions are at own expense. Deposit per person will be \$400.




















Flaith & Ellowship


