Training the Untrained to Reach the Unreached

The Timothy Initiative Expands



Our missionary Dan S. who has worked with the Global Training Network for the past 13+ years mentioned back in February and March that the Lord had opened an amazing new door of ministry for him to step through with The Timothy Initiative (TTI). The President and Founder of the Global Training Network was enthusiastic about the invitation that Dan received as a GTN missionary to serve TTI's vision as the largest international church planting movement in the world.

The "Mission and Vision" of The Timothy Initiative (TTI) exists to advance Christ's Kingdom by multiplying disciples and disciple making churches around the world. Their "Core Values" are: Kingdom Focused, Spirit Led & Scripture Based, Integrity First, Disciple Making Leads to Church Planting, Prayer is Priority, People Matter, and Faith Driven.

Since February, Dan has now become an "Ambassador" with the TTI and this past month he met with the TTI staff in North Carolina and was equipped, along with a small group of other US leaders to serve on a new TTI ministry team in which he will be involved in three primary areas of ministry.

- 1. Casting vision with individuals and at churches here on the West Coast to explain what the Vision and Goals and Methods of TTI's ministry are with the invitation to become involved in both the international and US TTI movement.
- 2. Giving training to churches to assist them in becoming more effective in equipping their church members to intentionally share their faith with the people in their relational network as mature followers of Jesus.
- 3. Giving training via Zoom to international pastors with whom he has established strong connections in India and elsewhere over the past 13 years. He is currently training these leaders in how they can implement TTI's New Testament based principles for church planting. This training will equip the international leaders to disciple their new converts to grow into their own lifestyle of sharing their new faith; guide these new believers into their own Christian maturity as followers of Jesus; and establish them as disciple-makers themselves of those they then lead to faith in Him.

God is definitely on the move; please keep Dan and all those working within the TTI in prayer that our Lord will guide and protect them as they disciple TTI's evangelism/discipleship ministry!



How exciting and blessed we are as a congregation to be welcoming Tim Hoins and his wife Kristy to be our pastor! I for one, was challenged and touched by Tim's sermon on Sept. 20, 2020. If you have not listened to it, I suggest you do. Tim challenged us to listen to God's

2020 EPC Askings



The EPC Per-Member "Askings" for 2020 are the same as last year for a total of \$38 per member. The \$38.00 per member "Askings" provides \$23 towards the EPC General Assembly (GA) while \$15 goes to the EPC Pacific Presby-tery region. The Per Member "Askings" are <u>voluntary</u> and the primary source of funding for both the GA & Pacific Region's budgets. Our Session wants to support the EPC and has committed to funding our 103 members for a to-tal amount of \$3,914.

Our goal this year is to raise 100% of the "Askings" which will again help reduce our operating budget expenses for the year. To date we have received \$1,384 (35.36%) toward our goal.

These "Askings" support: 1. The mission & service of the EPC to pursue God's vision to make a difference for Christ, the Gospel and the Kingdom of God in our communities, our country and the world; 2. The leadership which funds the committees, boards and special committees enabling them to pro-actively respond to the opportunities & challenges facing our growing denomination; 3. The ministry of the office of GA which serves, resources, connects and encourages EPC leaders, churches and presbyteries.

EPC is focusing this year on 4 strategic opportunities: 1) global movement, 2) transformation (church revitalization), 3) multiplication (church planting), and 4) effective biblical leadership. These exciting kingdom developments could not occur without your prayer and financial support.


